How to Make a Telehealth Appointment:

Before you join your telehealth appointment, make sure you are in an environment free of distractions and can speak freely.

Ask your local medical provider if they offer telehealth appointments. If yes, schedule your appointment.

Information about your telehealth appointment will be sent to your provided email. Do not discard this email as it has important information.

- **B** Visit the information in the email 30 minutes before your appointment.
- 4 Click the link provided to join your telemedicine appointment. Do not share this private meeting link with others.
- 5 It may say "Waiting for Meeting to Start,' as you wait for your doctor to join the meeting. Note that it may require you to download additional software to run your telehealth video appointment.

Have your phone nearby in case you experience any audio issues during the appointment.

End appointment by clicking 'End Call.'

Telehealth appointments are confidential and follow HIPPA regulations.
